Gospel—Mark 6:7-13

This week we learn about spreading the Good News.

Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out in pairs giving them authority to cast out evil spirits. And he instructed them to take nothing for the journey except a staff – no bread, no haversack, no coppers for their purses. They were to wear sandals, but, he added, 'Do not take a spare tunic.'

And he said to them, 'If you enter a house anywhere, stay there until you leave the district. And if any place does not welcome you and people refuse to listen to you, as you walk away shake off the dust from under your feet as a sign to them.' So they set off to preach repentance; and they cast out many devils, and anointed many sick people with oil and cured them.

Jesus also told us to go and make disciples. I wonder if sometimes we delay following his command because we think we aren't ready. If we would just go, like the Twelve did, he would give us the ability to share the Good News with others.



Father, we know that many people need to hear the Good News. Jesus has told us to go and make disciples; help us to be willing to go. Amen.
